



NDR Rally – Indianapolis – COVID-19 POLICIES/PROCEDURES

August 8-9, 2020

Marion County, Home to Indianapolis, Effective July 9, 2020:

“Unless exception applies, all individuals must wear a mask or face coverage over their nose and mouth when in an indoor place other than their own home, or when in outdoors in a situation where adequate social distancing of 6 feet is not possible (including outdoor public gatherings).”

To have a safe race the ISBDA and the NDR are putting the following mask requirements in place for all races until further notice.

This applies to EVERYONE. To help with that we will provide one gaiter style mask to each registered driver. We will have disposable masks available to volunteers/board members.

Face Masks will be required anytime you are unable to social distance examples include the following:

- *At the scales*
- *When riding inside the return trucks.*
- *When riding in the back of the truck.*
- *When riding on the golf cart.*
- *At the registration table*
- *When looking at the charts*
- *During wheel swaps*

Times when you do not need to wear your mask:

- *When driving down the track*
- *When in YOUR pit area with YOUR family*
- *In the restroom*

In addition to help with social distancing the NDR has made BOTH registration and payment available online. It is most helpful if you are able to do this before the day of the race but you will still be able to do it the day of the race which will eliminate the need for people gathering at the registration table.

The ISBDA and NDR will also have hand sanitizer stations throughout the facility, at the top, bottom, scales, wheel bank, registration and at the bathrooms.
